Know all men by these presents that I Rebecca Stone of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of forty dollars to me paid by Aris Cox of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell, and release unto the said Aris Cox all that plantation or tract of land containing twelve and a half acres more or less situate in the District aforesaid lying on the branches of Mountain Creek waters of Saluda River beginning on a rock 34 running thence N 7 W 1/2 50 to a small red oak 34 thence S 82 E 83.30 to the beginning bounding on the said Aris Cox Rebecca Stone and Rebecca Cox Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto him his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Aris Cox his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and in the fifty third year of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
