Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said John Baldwin his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the said John Baldwin his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and no other person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight And in the fifty third year of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of William Chaise Jr. J. P. Moon
