South Carolina ⁵² I know all men by these presents Greenville District ³ that I John Clark for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander Acker Junior have bargained sold and released and by these presents do bear gain sell and release unto said Alexander Acker a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and fifty acres lying on the waters of cedar Shoal Creek waters of Saluda River bounding as follows viz beginning on a white oak x3 thence N. 33. W. 31. to A post oak x3. Bounding on David Vinson thence S. 70 E. 24.50 to a Stake x3. Bounding on Elizabeth Vinson thence S. 9. E. 30.50 to a Stake x3. Bounding on John Clark thence S. 79. E. 40 to a Stake x3. Bounding on land belonging to the heir of Peter Acker thence N. 7. E. 26.50 to the beginning corner together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises or in any part incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander Acker his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto said Alexander Acker his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I hereunto affix my name and seal this 15 day of March in year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and 52nd year of the independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us Just Robert Drennen port
