 his Executors, admors & assigns for ever; provided, neverthe-  
 less and it is expressly agreed between the said parties  
 that should the said Frances Orby pay and discharge a certain  
 note given by the said Frances with the said Benj<sup>r</sup> as security  
 to Charles Orby Admors of Jas. Orby Decd. for upwards of
