 Consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to me paid  
 in hand by Wiley Burns of the district aforesaid the receipt whereof is here-  
 by acknowledged I have granted bargained sold conveyed and  
 confirmed unto the said Wiley Burns his heirs or assigns a certain tract  
 or parcel of land containing one hundred acres more or less sit-  
 uated in the District aforesaid on the south side of the Cane branch  
 beginning at a Stake on Beaufort line and runs as follows to a  
 black Oak thence with west line thence south forty seven degrees  
 West to the head of the Cattail branch thence northwardly up  
 the hill to a Chestnut thence along the ridge to main stream  
 N. to a white Oak corner thence down said branch to the be-  
 ginning being being a part of a tract of land granted to Robert  
 Prince which parcel of one hundred acres of land aforesaid  
 said together with all and singular the premises above men-  
 tioned unto the said Wiley Burns his heirs and assigns for ever  
 to have and to hold the premises aforesaid mentioned to  
 the sd Wiley Burns his heirs and assigns and I do for myself my  
 heirs Executors and Administrators warrant and forever defend  
 the premises aforesaid mentioned to the sd Wiley Burns his heirs Exe-  
 cutors and Administrators or assigns a gainst my self my Execu-  
 tors and Administrators and against every other person  
 or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
 same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this 14 day  
 of February 1822 signed sealed, and delivered in presence  
 of my Isaac B. Payne, John Spriggs, John <sup>in</sup> Barker  
 South Carolina }
