Carolina I know all men by these presents Grenville District that I James Hiett of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of Thirty dollars to me paid by James Creamer of the State & district aforesaid hath granted bargained sold and released, And by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Creamer, a plantation and part of a tract of land that was surveyed for Charles Rose on the 2nd day of Decr. 1793. the grant bearing date on the — day of — Recorded in grant Book. These part of the tract bounded to S. James Hiett Name from S. Hiett to S. Creamer one half of the original tract. Beginning at R.C. North side of the Reedy Fork of Reedy River a corner of the old tract running on the old line N. 62. W. crossing the Reedy fork Running opposite a black oak tree as will include one half the original tract to a stake thence across the old tract to the back line to a stake thence on the old line N. 55.
