 Greenville District } and entered in to between LeGrand  
 G. Walker Executor and Mrs Catharine LaBruce Executrix of the last  
 will and Testament of Joseph P. LaBruce deceased of the one part  
 and John H. Goodlett and Richard Goodlett of the other part  
 Witnesseth, that heretofore the said Joseph P. LaBruce John  
 H. Goodlett and Richard Goodlett made a joint purchase  
 of two tracts of Land, situated and lying on Georges creek  
 and its waters in what was lately in Pinckston District but now  
 Pickens District, one from James O. Lewis for the sum of three  
 thousand five hundred dollars, payable in two equal in-  
 -stalments, the first to be paid on the 25 day of December 1827  
 and the second on the 25 day of December 1828. with interest  
 from the day on which the first instalment fall due on  
 whatever sum then remains unpaid, the other from Sandy  
 Walker for the sum of six hundred and fifty dollars due  
 the first day of January 1827. to be held by them jointly in  
 equal shares; that since these purchases were made, and since  
 the death of the said Joseph P. LaBruce his Executor and  
 Executrix have covenanted, Contracted and agreed to ad-  
 -vance or a loan to the said Goodletts the sum of seven  
 hundred and fifty dollars, to be repaid with interest from  
 the 25 Decr. 1827. in two equal payments, the first on the  
 25 Decr. 1828. and the second on the 25. Decr 1829. Secured by  
 notes and a mortgage of the a fousaid two tracts of land  
 and a lien, convey and release unto the said Goodletts their  
 heirs and assigns in fee simple the said two tracts of land  
 and all the estate right and title which the said Joseph P.  
 had in his life time, and his heirs and representatives now  
 have in the said two tracts of land, and to Execute and Deliver  
 to the said Goodletts good and sufficient legal titles for the
