


To a Stake corner on Saluda River, thence up the said River to Obediah Hutsons corner on a Stake thence 40 E. 48 chained 50 links to the beginning corner on John Maxwells line this last tract contains one hundred and twenty six acres and three fourths, which united with the first make three hundred and twenty six acres and three fourths more or less hereby intended to be conveyed being the same tract of land that Dr. Thomas B. Williams conveyed to me by deed dated the fourth day of September 1819. by reference to that deed which is hereto appended will more fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the revision and revisions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said plantation tract and parcel of land with the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said John R. Mathews in trust for the said Mrs Ann Joor and her lawful children as aforesaid and I hereby bind myself and my heirs to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said John R. Mathews in trust as aforesaid forever against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
