



River Beginning at a white Oak 3x three running N. 45 E 31.50
to a post oak 3x three N. 55 W. 9 to a white oak 3x bounded by
William Stone & Meajah Jordan Land three S. 32 W. 4.50 to a red
Oak 3x at the head of hollow three S. 30 W. 5.50 to a sweet-
Gum 3x three S. 40 W. 10.50 to a white oak 3x near a spring. Thence
down the branch 10 chain to the beginning including the house
and part of the plantation wherein John Stone formerly lived
containing sixteen acres and a half to the same more or less
left together with all and singular the rights members heredita-
mies and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise appertaining to Stone and to hold all and singular
