 unto the said Benjamin Allston a certain negro girl called Winney  
 which I warrant sound a slave for life, and defend her against  
 me and my heirs and against every other person claiming her,  
 Witness my hand and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of Sept. A.D. 1828 -
