




Know all men by these presents that we William Pickett and Micajah Pickett Jur. of the State of Mississippi and Franklin County, for divers good Causes and Considerations, we living and being in the State of Mississippi and Franklin County have made ordained authorised, nominated and appointed and by these presents do make ordain, authorize, nominate and appoint James Pickett of the State of South Carolina Gwynn's District our true and lawful attorney for us in our names and for our own proper use and benefit to ask, demand, sue for recover and receive in the States of South Carolina and North Carolina all such sum or sums of money, debts or demands whatsoever, which are now due and owing to us or coming to us as our lawful Claim in said States to recover, ask and receive all and every manner and species of property coming to us in our own right or in right of any other person or persons for us in said States of South Carolina and North Carolina, and to act for us as our true and lawful attorney respecting any species of property what ever, which we may lawfully or Equitably claim in the aforesaid States of South Carolina and North Carolina, and to have use and take all lawful ways and means in our names or other wise for the recovery thereof by attachment, arrest, distress or other wise and to compound and give for the same and acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same for us and in our names to make seal and deliver and to do all other lawful acts and proceedings whatsoever concerning the premises as fully in every respect as we our selves or either of us might or could do were we personally present at the doing thereof. And attorneys one or more under him for the purposes aforesaid to make and again at his pleasure revoke ratifying and confirming and by these presents allowing whatsoever our said attorney shall in our names lawfully do, or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents.
