


Pickett and William Pickett as Executors as aforesaid of the said William Pickett Senior Deed and the authority of the same, and wishing to have the whole matter as Residuary Claimants under the said Bond and Covenant of the tenth of January eighteen hundred and five as aforesaid settled and closed doth hereby agree that James Pickett, of the State of South Carolina Greenville District a residuary claimant do and he is hereby authorized & empowered to receive so far as we as Executors do can authorize & empower out of the whole portion or sum of Cassandra Pickett the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to be paid to the said James Pickett on the first day of July next with interest from the seventh of July 1828 which said sum of fifteen hundred dollars & Interest shall not be chargeable to the Estate of William Pickett Senior Deed but to the legal heirs of Micajah Pickett and Cassandra Pickett which said sum of money is to be paid by the Commissioner in Equity for Greenville District South Carolina or any one of the acting trustees of said Bond as above mentioned for which a bond mentioned sum of fifteen hundred dollars with interest thereon be the said James Pickett is to board, clothe and support the said Cassandra Pickett with every thing necessary during of her natural life and at the death of the said Cassandra be the said James is to keep the said fifteen hundred dollars to his own proper use and benefit for ever as full compensation for the Board, Clothing Support & Allowance to the said Cassandra Pickett as witness our hands & seals this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D 1828 A.D in the sixth line from the bottom on the other side the word further is erased to the word above mentioned is intended is intended signed sealed and acknowledged for the use and purpose therein mentioned the date above written before me John Cameron Judge of Probate  Rufus H.
