Know all men by these presents that I David Westfield of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me paid by Humphrey Hall of the District and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Humphrey Hall all that lot tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid lying near Holly Spring meeting House bounded as follows to wit beginning at a Red Oak Bush &c. to a Stake running thence 3.36 running thence S. 7 W. 3 to a Spanish oak running thence 3.34 to the beginning corner bounded by David Westfield and Miller Burson land. Containing an acre of land it is for the use and purpose of a Burying Ground the said Hall is not to refuse any person from being buried on the acre of land. the said Acre of land is not to be sold by the said Humphrey Hall nor his nor assigns nor Executors it is allotted for the use of that Society. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises held -ning or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Humphrey Hall his heirs and assigns for ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Exrs. administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Humphrey Hall his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
