 Hunt. Beginning at a poplar on the West side of Brushy  
 Creek thence down said Creek to a post oak, thence S.  
 25 W. until it intersects Thompsons line, thence along his line till  
 it reaches the main road between Rudy and Saluda Rivers thence  
 up the said road till it intersects the upper line of the above  
 mentioned survey thence the said line by L. J. Allstons to  
 the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, numbers,  
 Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
