 acres of land lie the same more or less lying in Greenville
 District on the waters of Rawsons Creek beginning at a post oak
 running nearly a west course to a Stake on the road thence bend-
 ing on the road to a Stake thence a east course to the begin-
 ing corner together with all and singular the rights, members
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said
 premises or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto to
 so have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Thomas Watson his heirs and assigns for ever I do hereby bind myself my
