In witness whereof I the said Daniel Beacham have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and of the sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America the fifty fourth.

State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents <sup>271</sup> that I Benjamin Nelson of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by Samuel Campbell & Morgan Thompson of the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released unto the said S. Campbell & Thompson a certain tract of land containing one hundred and sixty two acres more or less lying on the South side of Pyles branch in the District and State aforesaid and waters of Ruddy River laid out as follows beginning on a Maple corner on Cockels line thence west to a P. C. on sd. Cockels line thence a long sd. Cockels line to a chestnut on Seaborn's line thence South a long sd. Seaborn's line to a stake corner on Thompson Dickerson line thence a long sd. J. Dickerson line to a pine knot corner on Pollard's line thence a long sd. Pollard's line to a black oak thence a long sd. Pollard's <sup>143</sup> line to a white C. on said branch thence up said branch to the beginning together with all
