that I William Turner of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for an in con-
sideration of twenty dollars to me in hand paid by Joshua Cox of the State
and district aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joshua Cox all that tract or
parcel of land containing thirty eight acres it being part of a tract
of 500 acres originally granted to John Sanders 11th day of January 1798
and Recorded in Grant book B. N. 5 Page 415 Situate in the state and
district aforesaid on the south side of Maple Creek waters of Enoree
River Beginning on a stake 3^x old made on Cooks line so called when
this said Land was first surveyed for said Sanders thence on said
line due W. 20 chains to a rd 0.3^x old made on said line thence
N. 20 W. 50 chains to a post oak 3^x thence due east a straight line
17 chains to Wm Edwards line thence S. 25 W. 50 chains on Wm
Edwards line to the beginning 3^x which includes feet thirty eight
acres of land together with all and singular the rights, members
humblements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining to the only proper use
and behoof of him the said Joshua Cox his heirs Executors adm-
inistrators and assigns myself my heirs Executors Administrators
and assigns and all and every person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof for
the same tract of land I will warrant and forever defend.

Witness my hand this 29th day January in the year of our Lord
Anno Domini 1816. And in the fourteenth year of American Independence
