hundred acres by estimation more or less situated in the dist aforesaid
on the Rocky fork whereof the Gold Groves Creek branch of Saluda
River which was originally granted to Robert Mcfield on the twenty
day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and eighty six beginning at a red Oak corner x 3 running
thence S. W. to a post Oak corner x 3 thence N. W. to a Stake
adjoining English land thence N. E. to a Stake corner x 3 joining
some Roberts land and English land thence S. E. to Stake
