 Tinsley of the District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknow-
 ledge HAVE granted bargained sold, released, Conveyed and confirm-
 ed and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, release convey and confi-
 rm unto the said James Tinsley his heirs and assigns a certain planta-
 tion tract or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred
 acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville District aforesaid
 on the branches of the North Fork of Saluda River and runs as
 follows that is to say Beginning on John Jacksons line a stake and
 painter Thomas Warrens corner thence North thirty four degrees west
 thirty one chains twenty two links to a Rock or stone thence to the
 old Ridge School House path thence said old path to a red
 oak Middleton Praytors corner thence an Eastwardly course with
 said Praytors line to a post oak on a line originally run for George
