 side of Chicharoc River waters of Saluda River and runs as follows. Viz Beginning on a stake
 on the south west side of said River where my lower line crosses the same thence N. eighty
 seven degrees W. to a poplar thence N. three degrees. W. seventy chains to a post oak thence S.
 eighty seven degrees E. to a stake on the said River thence down the meanders of the west
 bank of the old bed of said River to the Beginning being part of a tract of six hundred
 and forty acres of land granted to myself the fifteenth day of October one thousand
