 land which he purchased of Daniel McJunkin Jr thence along the
 said line that he purchased of Daniel McJunkin Jr to a large sycamore
 more on the river thence with the River to the mouth of the ditch the
 beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members
 incidents and appurtenances to the said premises or in any
 wise belonging to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Cleaveland his heirs and
 assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs to warrant
 and forever defend the same or any part thereof unto the said
