 in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars to me paid in hand by Silas R.
 Hawkins of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Silas R. Hawkins all that Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district aforesaid
 on the south side of Enoree River begining on a maple on the bank of sd River on street Thrustons corner thence running with a conditional line made
 between Gipson Southern and Aaron Kemp to a post oak corner on
 Samuel Braytons line to a — thence a long Samuel Braytons line to a Walm
 wt. corner thence along Braytons line to a Holly corner thence up the branch
 to a white oak corner on Markleys line thence a long sd line to a stone corner
 from thence to a Red Oak corner on Russells old line thence along Russells
 line to Mountain Creek thence down the meanders of sd Creek to a black gum
 corner on the no bank of said Creek from thence a long a conditional
 line made between Gipson Southern & John W. Southern to a post oak &
 thence a Conditional line to a post oak & an Gipson Southern pr. line
 thence a long a conditional line made between Gipson Southern and
 John Howell to a maple corner on the bank of Enoree River thence
 up the meanders of sd River to the beginning corner. Containing by
 Estimation one hundred acres more or less together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appertaining to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
 Have and to Hold. all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Silas R. Hawkins his heirs and assigns for ever And I do here
 by bind my self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Silas R.
 Hawkins his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and a
 gainst Every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming,
 or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and
 Seal this the 20 day of October 1829. And in the fifty fourth year
 of American Independence signed sealed and delivered in the
 presence of us the subscribers.
