W. 35. 50 to a Stake S.38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 34. 50 to a B. Jack S.70. E. 28 to a w. o. on a branch then up it to the fork at a maple then with the right hand prong to a Gum at the corner of N. 03. then S. 36. E. 11. to a Stake S. 33. W. 5 to a red oak, N. 54. E. 10. 05 to a white oak, thence S. 36. E. 23. 50 a crop two branches bounded by John Bruce land to a post oak stump, thence N. 42. E. 34. a crop of the great road and a branch to a pine bounded by Jno. Jany & Jno. Garrett land, then N. 38 W. 45. 50 to a black Gum then N. 44. W. 18 to a hickory the beginning corner of Lot No. 1st then N. 05.
