

Always, nevertheless, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said Thomas J. Doolin do, and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid, unto the said Samuel Mobley, the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, with the interest thereon if any shall be due, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note and then the deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine and be utterly null and void other wise it shall remain in full force and virtue. And it is agreed, by and between the said parties, that the said Thomas Doolin is to hold and in fee the said slaves until default of payment be made. Witness my hand and seal this nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fiftyfourth year of the sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America, signed, sealed, and delivered in presence of William Lake Jr.

W. 21.80 chains to a small white oak thence S. 45 W. 17 chains to a stone corner thence S. 45 E. 15.63 chs to the beginning to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Edward Croft his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular as the premises to the said Edward Croft his heirs and assigns against the claim of all manner of Persons who answer.
