Johnson on the other side which my Mother by the will of my Father is entitled to keep and enjoy during her life and which after her death is to be equally divided among the children to Have and to hold all such part of the said land as I may at the death of my mother be entitled to, or to my distributive share of the said tract should it be sold for partition and full power and authority in
