 DeKalb County } Thomas Hooper, John Hooper and William Legitim
 ate Childred and heirs of William Hooper late of Pendleton District
 in the State of South Carolina deceased which said heirs are hereby
 one year of age do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint and
 by these Presents do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Enoch
 Hooper our true and lawful attorney in fact and for us and in
 our names to ask, demand, receive sue for and recover all sums
 of money that may be due and owing to us from our Father's es-
 -tate to wit the said William Hooper, being our distributive share
 and portion of his estate in the hands of any person or persons in
 the state of South Carolina or elsewhere; and to sign, seal and
 deliver for us and in our names all proper and requisite receipts
 Bonds or other instruments and vouchers for the same to any per-
 -son or persons, Executors, administrators, Clerk, Sheriff Court of Or-
 -dinary and all or any person or persons holding any money or
 property belonging to the said William Hooper deceased as
 fully and amply as we or either of us might do were we or either
 of us personally present at the doing of the same. And to do all
 acts as our attorney in fact for the purpose of receiving all sums of
 money belonging to the said William Hooper deceased that may
 be necessary to receive the same from any person or persons holding
 the same. and also we nominate constitute and appoint said
 Enoch our attorney as aforesaid to ask, demand receive sue for
 and recover, all sums of money that may be due and owing us
 from the estate of our Grand Father Thomas Hooper late of
 Greenville District in the State of South Carolina deceased
