 and things whatever in and about receiving all sums of money from
 our said estate to wit William Hooper and our Grand father
 Thomas Hooper estate that we or either could personally do. And
 we do hereby revoke all former powers of attorney by us heretofore made
 or either of us and ratify all our said attorney or substitutes may
