Spencer and John McBlanchard's land on S.E. by Reuben Harrison's land Together with all and singular the rights men her Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns, against my self heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
