 Smith of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of  
 the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Peter Cauble of the same place  
 have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and  
 release unto the said Peter Cauble all that piece parcel or tract of land lying  
 and being in the District and State aforesaid situate on the East side of the  
 Enoree River being part of two tracts one originally granted to Enoch Benson  
 the other to John West. Beginning at a stake in the Road thence S. 50 E. 20.  
 50 to a Red Oak 37 thence N. 35 E. 44 to chestnut 37 thence N. 30 W. 18 to a stake in  
 the Road thence with the meanders of the road to the begining corner including  
 ninety one acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the  
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-  
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and  
 singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Peter Cauble his heirs and  
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
 to warrant and defend the said premises with their appurtenances to the said  
 Peter Cauble his heirs and assigns from me and my heirs and from every other  
 person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
