Logan of Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars unto me paid by James C. & William Foster, sons of Wiley Foster of the District aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said James C. & William Foster a certain Tract or plantation of land lying and being in the District aforesaid on the waters of Vaughns Creek a branch of N. Carolina River Beginning at a chernut thence S. 7 E. to a Black Oak thence S. 61. E. 51 E. 50 lbs. to a chernut thence N. 69 E. 24 E. to a Stake thence N. 23 E. to a Rock called the Cherokee corner thence N. 1/2 S. 66 E. 50 lbs. to the beginning containing by Estimation One hundred and forty three acres more or less the same being granted unto Elizabeth Martindale by patent bearing date 5th day of April 1819. by his Excellency John C. Calhoun and from her the said Martindale unto me together with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments, and appertinances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and To Hold the above mentioned premises unto J. James C. & William Foster their heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said James C. & William Foster their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the first day of April A.D. One thousand eight hundred and thirty and 54th year of America Independence
