son of the district and state above written for and in
consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by
Lawrence Lenhart of the State and district aforesaid the receipt whereof I do here
by acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and release convey and confirm unto the sd Lawrence Lenhart & his heirs and
assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying on a small branch of the Golden
Grove of Saluda River which sd tract is laid out to the sd Lenhart as follows
viz Beginning at a white oak ~~XXVII~~ on branch running S. 9° E 19 chains & 50 links
to a Dogwood ~~XXVII~~ on M. Halls line thence S. 70° W. 34 chains to a Stone ~~XXVII~~ on Judge
Gantt thence North 28 chains to a small hickory ~~XXVII~~ originally a Stake on Judge
Gantt thence west one chain to a Huckleberry on a small branch thence up
the meanderings of sd branch to a small maple ~~XXVII~~ thence N. 21° E 1 chain and
29 links to a Spanish Oak ~~XXVII~~ thence S. 81° E 4 chains & go links to a Stake ~~XXVII~~ thence
N. 45° E 24 chains to a post oak on W. Benson ~~XXVII~~ thence S. 20 chains & 40 links to
a Stake ~~XXVII~~ thence East 8 chains to a stone ~~XXVII~~ thence S. 67° W. 8 1/2 chains to the beginning
including one hundred and fourteen acres the same more or less it
being a part of a tract purchased by me the sd Thompson from Mr H
Flaming So. Have and to hold the sd parcel or tract of land with all
and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances, therunto
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. And I do hereby bind
myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and ever defend the sd bargained premises
unto the said Lawrence Lenhart his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs
and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof. Witness my hand and seal the 27th day of May in the year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty one signed sealed and delivered

Jacobs, his father witness the due execution thereof with himself sworn to this 4

sion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce, release and forever relinquish
all her interest and estate and also all her claim and right of dower unto the within named
Lawrence Lenhart his heirs and assigns of in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned
and aforesaid given under my hand and seal this 15th day of June A.D. 1831.
