 westerly to a Chestnut thence a long a conditional line to a
 maple corner on the Beamer dam creek thence a long said
 creek to a white oak thence to a pine Knot on Kellys line
 thence to a Spanish oak thence to the beginning corner Together
 with all and singular the a beore described premises To Have
 and To Hold all and singular the rights and premises and
 every thing appertaining thence unto of the a beore described
 Tract of land from me my heirs or assigns and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns
 to warrant and forever defend the same from myself my
 heirs Executors administrators or assigns or any other person
 whomsoever claiming or pretending to claim the same or any
 part thereof as witness where of I have set my hand and seal
 this 18th of December in in the year of our Lord 1829 and
 the fifty third of the Independence of the united States of
 America Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence
 of us John Smith, Jane ^{her} Smith } Drury ^{his} Smith Seal
