

62 This Indenture made this Eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Twenty nine Between Susanna Whitted Executrix of Hiram Whitted Deceased of the State of North Carolina and County of Buncomb of the one part and William Fuller of the State of South Carolina and Greenville district of the other part Witnesseth, as follows that for and Inconsideration of the Sum of five hundred dollars to me the said Susannah Whitted in hand paid by the said William Fuller the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged doth Grant bargain Sell and Deliver unto the said William Fuller his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcell of Land lying and being on both Sides of Middle fork of Hall Creek of the north fork of Saludia River bounded by Lands Entered by John Elledge begining at a Hickery west 48 poles to achesnut 6 poles to a stake N.E 74 poles to a stake S. 40 poles to the Begining containing one hundred acres more or less also another tract containing fifty acres more or less Begining on a white oak from thence North to a beach thence to a conditional line made between John Scatterey and John Morgan from thence to the begining also another tract containing Two hundred and fifty acres more or less Including the whole of the Sankford tract which Lands was conveyed from William Justice to Hiram Whitted together with all its ways Woods waters mines minerals and appurtenances to all the above mentioned lands unto the said William Fuller his heirs Executors or assigns against myself my heirs Executors or assigns and against the lawfull claim or claims of any other persons Whomessever as Witness my hand and Seal the day and date above Written.
