 that in and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and
 sixty three dollars to me the said Justice on hand paid by the sd
 Whitted the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged doth
 Grant Bargain Sell and deliver unto the said Hiram Whitted
 his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land whereon
 William Word now lives lying and being on both sides of Middle
 fork of fall Creek of the north fork of Saludia River bounded by
 Lands Entered by John Elledge beginning at a hickory 41 poles to a
 Chesnut 4 poles to a stake N. E. 74 poles to a stake So 40 poles to the
 Beginning containing one hundred ^{more} or less also another tract
 containing fifty Acres more or less Beginning at a white oak from
 from thence north to a beach thence to a conditional line made
 between John Heatherley and John Morgan from thence to the
 Beginning also another tract containing two hundred and fifty
 acres more or less including the whole of the Lankford tract to
 gether with all of its woods ways waters mines minerals and
 appertainances to all the above mentioned lands unto the said
 Hiram Whitted his heirs and assigns against myself my
 heirs and assigns and against the lawfull claim or claims
