 district aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and Released and by these
 presents do bargain sell and Release to the said Duke Harbin all that
 tract of Land being in Greenville District on Thompsons Beaver dam Creek
 Beginning on a maple where where John Penningtons line crosses said Creek
 and Runs East on to Penningtons Hickery Corner then North to a corner
 State Call'd for as the north Corner of a tract of Land sold to Lemuel Loftis
 by Ann Smith then due west to a black gum Corner on the said beverdam
 Creek with the Stream of said Creek down to the beginning Maple with the
 privilege of all the Spring water on both sides of the Creek Including one
 hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less and I the said Lemuel
 Loftis do bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto
 the said Duke Harbin his heirs and assigns forever against all and Every
 person that may claim the same or any part thereof in witness where
 of I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal the 3 day of October
 in the year of our Lord 1831
