

South Carolina To all to Whom these presents Shall come I William Blasingame Sheriff of Greenville district and State aforesaid Send Greeting Whereas by Virtue of Sundry writs of Fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common pleas held for Greenville district tested the Second day of July in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight at the Suit of Thomas Mc Carrell and others to me directed commanding me that of the Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements of A. F. Richards to levy the Sum of five hundred dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said A. F. Richards all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less Situate and being in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid on the Waters of Brushy Creek of Enore River adjoining Sundry Mc Bee land John Riviner A Waddle and Sartin Moore for amore particular Reference See original Grant made 1st April 1793 made to Lewis Rector and Whereas the said premises with their appertanances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri facias before mentioned have been Exposed to Sale at public Vendue and purchased by Joseph Edwards the third of the district Greenville for the Sum of forty five dollars being the highest Sum that was Bidden therefor Now Know year that I William Blasingame Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and In consideration of the said Sum of Forty five dollars to me in hand paid or Secured to be paid by the said Joseph Edwards the third the receipt and payment I do hereby Acknowledge have granted Bargained and Sold and by these presents do Grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Joseph Edwards the third heirs and assigns for Ever the said tract piece and parcel of Land with its appertanances and all the Estate right title and Interest which the said Archibald F. Richards of right had of in or to the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appertanances unto the said Joseph Edwards the third his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said William Blasingame might could or ought to Grant Bargain and Sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri facias or otherwise in Witness Whereof I the said William Blasingame have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the 30th day of November in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two
