The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Jacob Lendermon and John W Pollard their heirs and administrators on each of their parts and Behalfe shall and do in all things well and truly stand to and obey and abide by perform fully and keep the aforesaid order or arbitrament and final determination of John Wilkinson Joseph Dean and Aaron Payne on the one part and Cain Wells Anderson Bray and Brasher Henderson on the other party arbitrators Indefectly elected and made as well on the parts and behalf of the above bound Jacob Lendermon and John W Pollard as the above named arbitrators to arbitrate award order Judge and determine of and concerning all and all manner of action and actions cause and causes of action Bills Bills Bonds Speculations Judgments Executions Extents Quarrels Controversies Trespasses Damages demands whatsoever at any time here after had made moved brought commenced sued prosecuted done suffered committed or depending by and between the said parties so as the said award be made in writing under the hands of the said arbitrators or any four of them and ready to be delivered to the said parties Indifference or such of them as shall desire the same on or before the 23rd day of February 1834 then this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue Witness our hands and seals this day and date above written

We the arbitrators chosen by Jacob Lendermon and John W. Pollard to settle a case between them for Pollards raising the water from a dam on Reedy River on said Lendermon believe and determine that from a previous arbitration that decided on Pollards making said Lendermon compensation for a dam of ten feet that said Pollard shall not at any time exceed that height and if the present dam exceeds that height said Pollard shall cut it down to that height and if under that height the said Lendermon shall not receive any more damages than he has been heretofore received given under our hands this 22nd February 1834
