Pollard to settle a case Betwixt them for Pollards raising the Water from a dam on Cedy River on Said Sandermon Believe and determine that from a previous arbitration that decided on Pollards making Said Sandermon Compensation for a dam of Ten feet that Said Pollard Shall not at any time Exceed that Height and if the present dam Exceeds that Height Said Pollard Shall cut it down so that Height and if under that Height the Said Sandermon Shall not receive any more Damages then then has been heretofore received Given under our hands this 22nd February 1834
