 divers good causes do give and bequeath unto my two daughters
 Harriett and Geroby H. Smith a certain tract or parcel of land sit-
 uate on Middle fork of Saludia River in the district aforesaid and
 lying as follows (viz) Beginning on a Spanish oak corner on R. Row
 lands line thence S.15.W.11. to R. Jack & thence S.89.W.5.50 to E. 0 3x thence
 N.53.W.22.50 to a hickory & on the West Side of the river thence N.35
 E.13 to a chestnut & on Jeremiah Clevelands land thence N.46.E.40.00
 to a R. 0 3x thence S.14.W.42.00 to the begining the said tract contain-
 ing seventy five acres but the said arld Geroby are not to have free
 use and benefit of the above mentioned land untill after my death
 and the death of my wife Jane Smith but after our deaths they are
 to have the same and do with it as they may think proper given
 under my hand and seal this 22nd day of April 1834
