244 The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Edward Croft of Greenville district in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred dollars to me paid by John Clark of Spartanburgh District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Clark all that lot or tract of land situate on the Buncomb road near Greenville Village in in the State aforesaid containing sixteen acres and thirty eight perches according to the Survey of John Watson on the fifth day of June AD 1832 be the same more or less beginning at a point oak corner on the West side of the said Buncomb road and running thence North 44° East sixteen chains to a small red oak corner thence South 86° East six chains to a red oak corner thence South 40° East three chains and fifty links to a white oak corner then commencing again at the beginning corner and running thence South 35° East eight chains and thirty links to a stake being the corner of George Crofts land thence North 44° East twenty chains and seventy five links to the aforesaid white oak corner near a branch bounded on the North by lands of said Edward Croft and David Long on the East cornering upon David Hennings land and bounding on the South upon George Crofts land and upon the West upon Warden McBees lands together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Clark his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
