and State aforesaid send greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of
Hieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the
District of Greenville tested the twentieth day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three at the suit
of Barksdale Garrison to me directed commanding me that of the
Goods and Chattels lands and tenements of Moses Garrison to levy the
Sum of two hundred and fifty dollars Damages and Costs I have
Seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said
Moses Garrison all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land
containing one hundred and seventy acres Situate and being in the
District of Greenville on the Golden Grove whereon Deft now lives adjoin-
ing lands of David Garrison Robert Maxwell and John Townes
and Whereas the said premises with their appertinances since the
Seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Hieri Facias
before mentioned have been Exposed to Sale at Public Vendue and
purchased by Barksdale Garrison of the District of Greenville for the
Sum of one hundred dollars being the highest Sum that was Bidden
therefor now know year that I William Blasingame Sheriff aforesaid
by virtue of the said writ of Hieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and
Delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made
and provided and for an Inconsideration of the said Sum of one
hundred dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the
said Barksdale Garrison the receipt and payment whereof I do
hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained and sold and by
these presents do Grant Bargain and sell unto the said Barksdale
Garrison his heirs and assigns for ever the said tract piece and
parcel of land with its appertinances and all the Estate right
title and Interest which the said Moses Garrison of right had of in
unto the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract
of land with its appertinances unto the said Barksdale Garrison
his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said
William Blasingame might could or ought to Grant Bargain and
sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said
writ of Hieri Facias or otherwise in Witness whereof I the said William
Blasingame have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty fifth
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty four
