 Newberry District in the state aforesaid have Granted Bargain sold
 & Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and release
 unto the Said Gurtys B. Atwood all that Lot or tract of land situate on
 The Buncomb road near Greenville village in the State aforesaid con-
 taining sixteen acres and thirty eight Perches according to the Sur-
 vey of John Watson on the fifth day of June AD 1832 be the same
 more or less Beginning at a post oak corner on the west side of said
 Buncomb road and running thence North 44^o East 16 chains to a
 small red oak corner thence South 84^o East 16 chains to a red oak
 corner thence South 40^o East three chains and fifty links to a white
 oak corner then commencing again at the Beginning corner
 and running thence South 35^o East Eight chains & thirty links
 to a stake being the corner of George Crofts land thence North
 44^o East Twenty chains & seventy five links to the aforesaid white
 oak corner near the branch bounded on the North by lands
 of Edward Crofts and David Long on the East bounding
 upon David Hennings land and bounded on the South upon
 George Crofts Land and upon the West upon N. McBees
 Land & together with all and singular the rights members here-
 detiments and appertainances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Gurtys B. Atwood his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to war-
 rant and forever defend all and singular the so premises
 unto the said Gurtys B. Atwood his heirs and assigns against
 myself & my heirs & all other persons lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand & seal
 this twenty Eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred & thirty five & the fifty ninth year of the
 Independence of the united States of America
