McCullough his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for  
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jas Moulton  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every  
other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
in any part thereof, witness my hand and seal this in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty eighth year of the  
independence of the United States of America
