

9. Thence West 17 to a stake 3x on the North Fork of Mountain Creek thence down
 the meanders of said Creek to the beginning containing forty and a corner the same
 more or less together with all and singular the rights, manors, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any incident or
 appurtenance to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 do mentioned unto the said R. Cobb his heirs and assigns forever and I do
 hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said R. Cobb
 his heirs and assigns against myself and against my heirs and every other
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof Witness my hand and seal this 15th Decr 1834 and fifty eighth
 year of the United States of America.
