 Greenville District } district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the  
 sum of one hundred dollars to me secured to be paid by Reubin Ayres  
 of the district and state aforesaid have granted given and released the  
 Reubin Ayres from all Damages that I have sustained by his having  
 caused my land to be overflowed and do by these presents Give & Grant  
 unto the said Reubin Ayres his heirs and assigns forever to continue  
 to have the privilege to keep his mill Dam to its present Height  
 forever and I do here by bind myself my heirs to Warrant and forever  
 defend the said privilege before mentioned unto the said Ayres his  
 heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person  
 or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Given  
 under my hand and seal 11<sup>th</sup> 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1834
