


State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Pollard  
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand  
 paid by Eli Pollard of the district and state aforesaid have granted Bargain  
 sold and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the  
 said Eli Pollard a plantation or tract of Land lying and being in the district  
 aforesaid on a branch of Needy River known by the name of Casly, Branch  
 being part of a tract of Land originally granted to John Pyle sent by his  
 Excellency Governor Moutrey the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September 1786 Beginning on a post  
 on the road in a hollow above said Eli Pollards on the south side then  
 running straight to the lower end of my Spout at Spring then running S<sup>o</sup>  
 ward to Corner on May fields land above his old place then with this line  
 in an northward direction to Duns line then to original State Corner and in  
 the same direction to my mill Road then up said road to the beginning  
 of oak including one hundred acres more or less to have and to hold  
 together with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Eli Pollard his heirs heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs &c to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises  
 here mentioned unto the said Eli Pollard his heirs and assigns against  
 myself my heirs and every other person lawfully claiming the same in  
 Witness hereof I do set my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of February 1834  
 signed sealed and Delivered  
 in presence of John W Pollard
