 -chain to a hickory 3x bounded by Joseph McCullough's land thence
 N 6 E 3. 90. to a hickory 3x thence N 82 E 41. 40 to a Stake 3x thence S 44 W 16. 20
 to a black Oak 3x thence S 49 W 45. bounding on Jesse French's
 Land to a black 3x on Saluda River thence up the meanders
 of said River to the beginning together with all and singular
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same
 belonging as in anywise incident or appertaining to have to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Said Vincent
 Thomason his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves
 our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally to warrant
 and for our defence unto the Said Vincent Thomason his heirs and assigns
 all and singular the premises above mentioned against ourselves
