 Bridge with the privilege of the Landing in Anderson District
 also the privilege of building and rebuilding the said Bridge & do
~~hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant~~
~~and defend the said Bridge with~~ unto the said Hiram
 Hooley his heirs Executors and Administrators for ever & I do
 hereby bind myself to warrant and for ever defend the said
 Bridge with the Landing above mentioned from myself my
 heirs Executors and Administrators and from every other person
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 in writing whatsoever I do hereby set my hand and seal this
 the tenth day of March Eighteen Hundred and Thirty six
 I do hereby certify the crossing of all those who helped build
 the bridge now standing that they shall crop toll free as
 long as the said Bridge stands signed sealed and delivered
 in the presence of Hugh Poor Seal
