 John W Hodges his heirs and assigns forever. The above described premises
 with the exception of the foregoing reservations are conveyed together with
 all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenan-
 ces to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apper-
 taining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises
 to the said John W Hodges his heirs and assigns forever. And I do
 hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
 and defend the said premises unto the said John
 W. Hodges his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and
 against every person or persons who shall lawfully claim
 in or to claim the same or any part thereof I witness where
 of I have herein to set my hand and seal this 15th day of Aug
 1833 in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and
