State of South Carolina } I know all men by these presents that I Raleigh Hood
 Greenville District } of the County Munroe and State of Tennessee
 for the consideration of five Dollars to me in paid
 by Alexander Mc Kinney } of the District of Greenville and State of
 South Carolina, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have
 granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bar-
 gain, sell and release unto the said Alexander Mc Kinney all and
 singular the plantation or tract of land known by the name of the
 Pulte place situate in Greenville District on both sides of the mid-
 dle fork of Saluda River Beginning on a Spanish Oak running
 thence So 32. Wth 25 Chain to a white oak, thence So 58 Eth to a
 hickory, thence to a hickory, thence to a horn beam on the bank
 of the River, thence up the River to an ash thence crossing the
 River So 58. Est - extending so far with said line, untill it strikes
 a conditional Corner made on said line by the said Raleigh Hood and
 Lee Hendrix running from said conditional Corner to a poplar
 in a hollow near an old schoolhouse, from thence nearly a North East
 Course untill it strikes the upper line of said tract, thence North
 58 West to the beginning. Containing two hundred Acres be the
 same more or less. Together with all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Alexander Mc Kinney his Heirs and Assigns for
 ever I do hereby bind my self my Heirs Executors and Administrators
 to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said Land & premises
 unto the said Alexander Mc Kinney his Heirs and Assigns and against my
 self my Heirs and against all and every person or persons lawfully
 claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have
